Enrollment

Headcount	Unduplicated count of credit and non credit students, each student is counted only once regardless of their seat counts or contact hours
Full Time Student Equivalent (FTSE)	Total number of student term credit hours divided by 30 plus total non-credit contact hours divided by 640

Persistence	Students who are new to PCC (VFA Main cohort) and enrolled in the fall semester who returned to college and enrolled in the next spring semester (e.g. Fall 2024 to Spring 2025) The VFA Main Cohort 2024 persistence goal is based on a 10-year average to align with the 2024-2025 Chancellor's Goal
Retention	Students who are new to PCC (VFA Main cohort) and enrolled in the fall semester who returned to college and enrolled in the next fall semester (e.g. Fall 2024 to Fall 2025)

Completion and Transfer
